



Changing the BSC Arrangements - Modifications Process

Who should attend? This course will interest customers who have attended the Introduction Seminar and want more detail on the Modification Process. It will also be useful for customers in a technical or change management role within their organisation and interested in the progression of Modifications. This course is ideally grouped with our 'Changing the BSC Arrangements – Change Proposal Process' and 'Implementation of BSC Systems Releases' courses as they are closely linked.

- The impact of a 'Relevant Challenge'.
