



Overview of Supplier Volume Allocation

Who Should Attend? This course will interest customers working in electricity supply either at a Supply business or with a Data Collector, Data Aggregator or Meter Operator. Delegates will ideally have some experience of the Supplier Volume Allocation (SVA) arrangements and looking to broaden their knowledge base and understanding.

- The roles and responsibilities of Suppliers, Supplier Meter Registration Agents, Supplier Agents, SVA Agent, the Profile Administrator and other related BSC Agents;
- How Supplier volumes are calculated;
- The reconciliation and settlement timetable ;
- Metering and settlement;
- The eight profile classes;
- How estimates of annual consumption and annualised advances are calculated and used within settlement;
- What Grid Supply Point Group Correction is and how it's determined.
